
French

Complete up to and including Page 7 of your nutrition booklet.

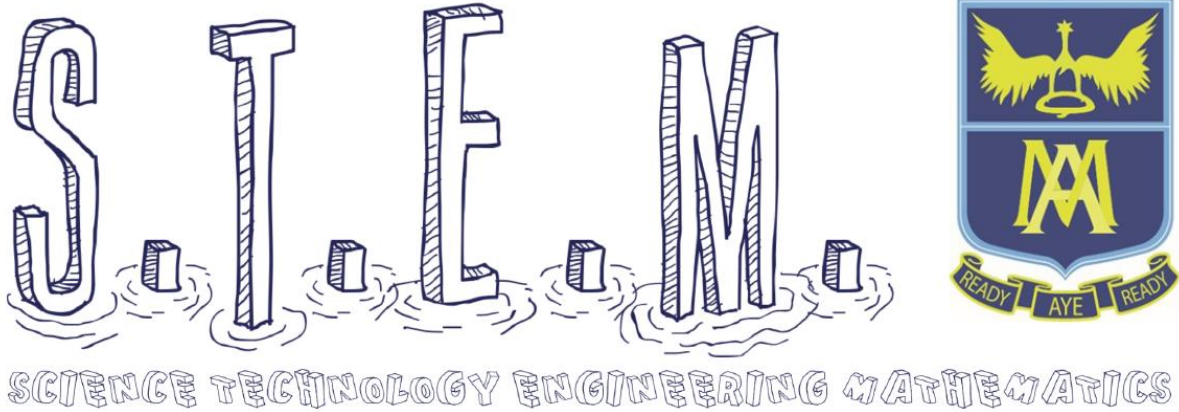
S1 RMPS - World Religions
